



# CONSTRUCTION ALERT

## Road Closure and Detour at Clyde Avenue in Kissimmee

Motorists are seeing significant changes at the railroad crossing on Clyde Avenue as part of SunRail's Phase II Expansion Project. The changes are needed for safety improvements at the existing intersections near the crossing.

The City of Kissimmee recently opened a newly constructed extension of Beaumont Avenue to connect with Lakeview Drive at the traffic circle, and closed Lakeview Drive just before the railroad crossing to the west of the traffic circle.

On Friday night, August 25, SunRail crews will close Clyde Avenue in both directions at the railroad tracks to install a new crossing. Clyde Avenue will remain closed until about 5 a.m. Monday, August 28.

Traffic on Clyde Avenue will be directed around the closure using Palmetto Avenue, John Young Parkway and Portage Street or Hughey Street. Please see the map on the back of this page for more information. Detour signs will be placed throughout the area to direct drivers, and access to residences will be maintained.

Also as part of the safety improvements, eastbound traffic on Penfield Avenue is stopped before the intersection with Clyde Avenue, and access to Penfield Avenue from Clyde Avenue is restricted to a right turn from southbound Clyde Avenue only. Westbound traffic on Clay Street will be permitted to only turn right onto northbound Clyde Avenue.

SunRail's Phase II South extension project is adding approximately 17.2 miles of new rail line between the Sand Lake Road station in Orange County and the Poinciana station in Osceola County. The project also involves double-tracking most of the corridor.
