# **ABOUT SUNRAIL**

#### **Welcome Aboard**

On May 1, 2014, SunRail service debuted in Central Florida, providing residents, businesses and visitors alike with a fast, efficient, cost-effective and reliable commuting option to the region's congested road network. In 2018, SunRail expanded to 16 stations and operates along 49 miles, roughly paralleling Interstate 4, serving the heart of the business district in downtown Orlando, Volusia, Seminole, Orange and Osceola counties.

SunRail runs Monday-Friday, every half hour during peak service periods in the morning and evening to best serve the business commuter. During the midday and later evening, SunRail trains operate approximately every 90 minutes, providing options for shift workers, leisure travelers and other passengers.

With state-of-the-art technologies and comfortable seating on board each train, SunRail offers passengers a stylish and relaxing alternative to their traditional commute. Amenities on board include:



One Ad Placement = One Poster on 10 passenger vehicles


Contract Minimum: Placement Cost: Production Fee: One Year \$7,600/year or \$650/month \$550 (one-time)


#### Annual Cost Per Ad Per Station: \$3,300
